- ☐ The word 'Global' here means International or Worldwide and it can also be referred to as a platform where buyers and sellers are interacting real time across the globe.
- ☐ The word 'Financial' is a broad term used to describe many aspects of money or finance.
- ☐ The term 'Market' talks about any location where traders meet to trade or buy/sell instruments, seeking to make gains.
- ☐ Global financial market is the worldwide online marketplace where buyers and sellers trade financial assets such as Stocks, Indices, Bonds, Currencies and Commodities across national borders at prices that reflect supply and demand.



Global Financial Market: History

- ☐ Trading started long time ago dating back to the trade by barter system, which is exchanging what you have for what you need.
- ☐ Trading in the global financial market requires one to be able to speculate price movement of a financial asset over a period of time in other to make profit.
- eTrading is all about buying and selling financial instruments electronically with the sole purpose of making profit online.
- eTrading in GFM brings higher returns and in a very short period.



Financial Market Overview

Anyone can trade the financial market, so far you have access to an electronic device that can connect to the market via the internet. Traders around the world trade either as a group- as in larger corporations or as an individual- retail trader.

Access To The Market

You can access the market via a trading platform on your internet-enabled devices 24-hours a day, from Monday through Friday.

Unlike other exchanges such as NYSE, NSE etc with closing times daily, GFM doesn't have a closing time. Once the market is open on Monday, it doesn't close until Friday night

Currencies

Currency is defined simply as a bill of exchange, acceptable as a legal tender for payment for goods and services.

Currency trading is the exchange of a nation's currency with that of another nation thereby making profit from continuous changing price rates when compared to each other.

Types of Currency Pairs

Currencies are traded in pairs.

There are three (3) types of currency pairs namely:

- I. Major pairs; EURUSD, USDJPY, GBPUSD...
- 2. Minor pairs; USDPLN, USDNOK, EURSEK...
- 3. Exotic pairs; USD/ZAR, EURTRY, USDHUF...

Benefits Of Trading Currencies



High Liquidity

The high liquidity in trading currency means that transactions can be completed quickly and easily, so the transaction costs – or spreads – are often very low. Due to a large number of buyers and sellers looking to make a trade and profit at any given time.



No Market Control

The foreign exchange market is so huge and has so many participants that no single entity can control the market price for an extended period of time.

The exchange market has no restrictions for directional trading. There's Profit Potential from Rising and Falling Prices

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Commodities

Commodities are basic goods used in commerce; commodities are most often used as inputs in the production of other goods or services. Commodities are classified into three groups: Metal, Energy, or an Agric produce.



Commodities - Metals

Metals are quite volatile as sentiment swings. Traders tend to flock to gold in times of economic hardship...

This is called a "flight to safety"

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Benefits of commodities trading



Diversification

Commodities can diversify a portfolio. So often, when bonds and stocks fall, commodities rise

Access to information

Commodity trading online is fast becoming more and more popular because traders now have access to well-researched information to help them make good judgment when investing in commodities.

High returns

Commodity markets are volatile. They can experience huge swings in prices. For example, a war in a major oil-producing country like Iraq can cause oil prices to shoot up.

Smart investors can take advantage of these price swings to make gains.



Bonds - Definition



A Bond is a debt investment in which an investor loans money to an entity (typically corporate or governmental) which borrows the funds for a defined period of time at a variable or fixed interest rate.

Examples are Government Bond, Private Company Bond e.g. CHNcomp



Stocks & Indices

as a shareholder or stockholder selected stocks together of that company.

Stocks are traded on exchanges all over the world, the largest is the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE).


A stock is an ownership share in Indices are also known as Market a corporation. Each of these Index, which is a combined value shares denotes a part ownership generated by adding a group of expressing their total value as a unit to represent an entire Stock market capitalization.



Example of Indices are:

US30, US100, UK50, DE30, FRA40...

Market Indices are essentially groupings of the top listed Equities on a particular Exchange/Market/Region and the average value is the market CAP of the grouping.

Key economic events such as interest rates, CPI's, PPI's, GDP, Inflations among others


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Key monetary policies and speeches by bank heads around the world.


